



ST KILDA FESTIVAL 2012

NOTIFICATION OF ROAD CLOSURES – FORESHORE AREA

The St Kilda Festival is again approaching, and the 2012 main Festival day will take place on **Sunday 12th February 2012**.

As in previous years, a number of full and partial road closures affecting access to your area will be in place on Festival Day between the hours of **5:00am and midnight**.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused by these road closures and hope the information provided here will help minimise the disruption to your business or organisation. The attached map explains exactly where the following road closures will be located.

FULL ROAD CLOSURES (NO ACCESS TO ANY TRAFFIC)

- Fitzroy Street, between Grey Street and The Esplanade (including the Acland Street intersection);
- The Esplanade between Fitzroy Street and Acland Street;
- Lower Esplanade, between Cavell Street and Jacka Boulevard;
- Acland Street, between Carlisle Street and Barkly Street, and Fitzroy Street and Jackson Street;
- Cavell Street;
- Shakespeare Grove, between Acland Street and Chaucer Street;
- Pier Road; and
- Beaconsfield Parade and Jacka Boulevard between Acland Street and Cavell Street.

PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURES (LOCAL ACCESS FOR RESIDENTS ONLY. ACCESS PERMITS MAY BE REQUIRED)

- Carlisle Street, between St Kilda Road and Acland Street;
- Grey Street between Fitzroy Street & Barkly Street and all side streets off Grey Street; and
- Acland Street and all side streets between Jackson and Carlisle Streets.

OTHER CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS


- **Fitzroy Street:** no vehicle access will be provided at St Kilda Road. Access at Princes Street will be limited to Local Traffic Only (no permits required);
- There will be no access from Canterbury Road into Fitzroy Street and no access from Grey Street into Fitzroy Street. The **Grey/Fitzroy/Canterbury** intersection will have a full closure with no access provided at this point;
- **Jackson Street:** the 'one-way' section of Jackson Street between the rear of the 7-11 convenience store (bend in the street) to Grey Street will be changed to 'two-way' traffic;
- **Acland Street:** the 'one-way' section of Acland Street between Eildon Street and St Leonard's Avenue will be changed to 'two way' traffic;
- **Robe Street:** the 'one-way' section of Robe Street will also be changed to 'two-way' traffic;
- **Wimmera Place:** will be changed to 'two-way' traffic;
- **Beach Road:** (Beaconsfield Parade, Jacka Boulevard, Marine Parade and Ormond Esplanade) will be closed between St Kilda Street and Kerferd Road, local traffic access is permitted via side streets, without a permit; and
- The installation of a disability drop-off and pick-up zone on Beaconsfield Parade, adjacent to Catani Gardens.

TAXI RANKS

- During the Festival a special taxi rank will be operational on Fitzroy Street between Balluk William Court and Lakeside Drive. (see attached map for further location details).
- The taxi rank located at the corner of Fitzroy Street and Acland Street will be operational once roads re-open at the conclusion of St Kilda Festival.
