



Ruth Nangle Trophy and Jeanette Turnbull Trophy Hosted by Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron

NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority for the Ruth Nangle and Jeanette Turnbull trophies is Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. RMYS Sailing Instructions V6.0, the Ruth Nangle and Jeanette Turnbull Supplementary Sailing Instructions, the AMS rating system, the IRC rules parts 1, 2 and 3, the Yachting Victoria handicap system and the requirements of the Port of Melbourne Corporation (PoMC) will apply.
- 1.3. AS special regulations Part 1 Sections 1-6, Category 6 for racing boats shall apply.
- 1.4. All yachts shall complete a crew declaration as part of the online entry form. This may be updated up until 1 hour prior to the warning signal.
- 1.5. No anchor shall be carried on deck forward of the stem or with any part protruding outboard.
- 1.6. Spinnakers are permitted for the pursuit race.
- 1.7. All yachts will need to sign on via radio (Ch 72) before the warning signal of each race. Failure to do so may result in being scored DSQ. The sign on procedure will be detailed in the sailing instructions.
- 1.8. All yachts must give way to commercial vessels. Failure to do so may result in being scored DSQ.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The races are open to all yachts that:
 - 3.1.1. All yachts shall lodge, with their home club, an Australian Sailing (AS) 2017-2021 Special Regulations Equipment Audit Form, valid for the current season.
 - 3.1.2. Have affixed a minimum category 6 safety sticker (2018-19) to their transom (if supplied),
 - 3.1.3. Have shown proof of appropriate third party and personal insurance cover, with a minimum of AUD \$10,000,000 public liability.
 - 3.1.4. Can ensure that while the yacht is racing, equipment necessary to comply with the relevant safety prescriptions is carried and the appropriate level of insurance cover is maintained.
- 3.2. Eligible yachts may enter by completing the online entry form on the RMYS website. Telephone entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.
 - 3.2.1. A yacht on the RMYS register with an owner/part owner or crew member with an account in arrears or without a temporary member day pass may be disqualified.
- 3.3. Entries will close at midnight on Thursday 21 February 2019.

4. Fees

- 4.1. Eligible yachts on the RMYS register will not be charged entry fees.
- 4.2. Yachts not on the RMYS register will be charged \$30 per race to a total of \$60 for both races.
- 4.3. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Sailing Coordinator and shall be charged a fee of \$30.

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1. RMYS Sailing Instructions V6.0 and amendments are available from the RMYS Office or the RMYS Website.
- 6.2. The Ruth Nangle & Jeanette Turnbull Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1700hrs on Thursday 21 February 2019 on the RMYS Website and by the RMYS noticeboard.

7. Venue

- 7.1. The race will be conducted on the waters of Port Phillip.

8. Courses

- 8.1. The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Supplement to the Ruth Nangle & Jeanette Turnbull Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

9. Radio Communication

- 9.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

10. Berthing

- 10.1. Berthing will be available at Martha Cove Marina. Rental agreements are available on the Special Entry page on the RMYS website.

- 10.3. Payment for berthing must be made directly to Martha Cove Marina via telephone - 5987 0827

11. Social Events

- 11.1. Safety Beach Sailing Club are offering a social function package (in conjunction with Sail Peninsula) on Saturday 23 February at a cost of \$62pp. This includes a 2-course gourmet buffet, live entertainment and a courtesy bus to the marina.
- 11.2. Dinner service commences at 1830. The courtesy bus will run between 1600-2330.
- 11.3. Entry wristbands must be collected from the regatta office prior to attending dinner.
