Pier Road, St Kilda 'No entry' ban - Clarification of the authorised vehicles

I refer to the on site meeting on Friday, 27 February 2009 attended by yourself and a number of your officers, regarding the antisocial behaviour of some drivers in Pier Road, St Kilda.

One of the issues discussed in order to help to resolve these illegal and antisocial activities is the enforcement of the 'No entry – Authorised vehicles exempt' restriction in Pier Road, west of the access to Sea bath car park.

The purpose of the installation of the entry ban is to discourage any through traffic entering from this end of Pier Road, while not impacting on the operation of the existing businesses off Pier Road.

The City of Port Phillip therefore clarifies that the authorised vehicles that are exempt from the existing No entry restriction in Pier Road are:

- Vehicles of patrons and members of the Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron
- Service vehicles to St Kilda Pier (Kiosk, Parks Victoria, Ferry etc)
- Police and emergency vehicles
- Council service vehicles
- Any other vehicles that their drivers can satisfy Police with their answer about the purpose of being there and the need for driving through the 'No entry' sign.
