## Olympic Bar and Balcony House Rules

Members, guests and visitors are requested to respect the Squadron Rules. A more detailed explanation may be found in the Red Book and the RMYS Constitution.

Please ask at the office for a copy of these documents.

- All guests and visitors must be signed in.
- Members, guests and visitors must be neatly dressed.
   Wet weather gear, bathers, singlets (other than ladies' dress singlets),
   overalls, work clothes, boiler suits, and dirty or torn clothes are not permitted.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times.
   Rubber thongs, work boots or sailing/sea boots are not considered appropriate footwear.
- Hats or caps shall not be worn in the Olympic Bar.
- No offensive language.
- No Smoking, except on the balcony.
- Sailing bags are not permitted on the balcony or in the Olympic Bar (they should be stored in lockers or on the shelving at the top of the internal stairs).
- Animals are not permitted.
