Case Introduction:

Redress sought by Rollercoaster and 3 other boats due to errors made by the RO

Procedural Matters:

There were no conflicts of interest.

Facts found:

Pursuit races started on time at 1300. 2 divisions - spinnaker and non spinnaker

Course 36 selected for the non spinnaker division

Time limit of the race is 1600

8 boats started the race

The wind peaked at 10 knots

At 1504 the RO radioed that the race would be shortened at C and requested that they take their own finish time

At 1515 the race was abandoned via radio

Time limit of the race is 1600

Blue Horizon retired before the race was shortened. Siren retired before the race was abandoned.

Rollercoaster radioed that 4+ boats within half a mile of C mark. The boats that took their finish time at C were Rollercoaster (1), Jacobina (2), Archimedes (3), Boots (4). Charlotte and Dalliance had not retired from the race

Conclusion & Rules:

Rule - to be updated

Errors were made by the RO. It was possible that half the fleet could finish the course within the time limit based upon the shortened course. The boats stared and raced in good faith. The race communication was understood

Decision:

The non spinnaker division was subject to an error by the RO and the results for the boats (PHS division) will be given. Results for Charlotte (5) and Dalliance (6) to be given. No results to be given for the ORC or AMS Division.
