# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **Arriving at RMYS.**

Your marina berth will be allocated by RMYS. Contact Jan Hurst in our Membership department on 03 9534 0227 before arrival to discuss where to go.

You will need to provide your own mooring lines and fenders. There will be shore power and water available.

Berthing will be free of charge from 12:00am Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January and 12:00am Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2024. Standard RMYS berthing charges will apply before and after those times/dates.

### **Support Boats.**

If you plan to bring a support boat and sleep on board during the Championship, please check with RMYS ASAP regarding availability. Please have the vessel name, draft, length and date you plan to arrive, and a copy of your vessel's insurance handy.

#### Marina and Club access.

Access in and out of the marina and the Club does require a fob key. Contact the RMYS office to organize this if you require it before Friday. One fob key will be allocated to each skipper.

On Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> January O2 Events will be staging Race 3 of the 2XU Triathlon Series. Beach Road will be closed from Kerferd Road, Middle Park to St Kilda Street Elwood from 06:00 to 11:00.

There will be a 'Managed Crossing' of the course at the intersection at Beach Road and Cowderoy Street/Pier Road to access RMYS & the St Kilda Sea baths. Please follow the directions of the Marshals to ensure the safety of all concerned.

#### **Rubbish on the Marina**

All rubbish generated on boats should be taken to the clubhouse and placed in the appropriate bins in the garbage area. Both recycle and general waste bins are provided. No garbage is to be placed in the bins located on the Marina.

# Transport/Car parking.

All day metered car parking is available along Pier Road, to the north of the club.

The nearest tram stop is the No 96 Stop near the cnr of Fitzroy St and Beaconsfield Pde, also route 16 and 3a trams service the area. There are no trains close by.

### Catering.

St Kilda has numerous cafés nearby for breakfast/lunch provisions and that all important morning coffee

The bar will be available for takeaway drinks prior to racing and open to 9pm other nights.

Don't forget the BBQ on Friday night and the ticketed Saturday night function.

Presentations will be made as soon as possible after the Sunday racing.

# **Saturday Night Dinner.**

Tickets for the dinner are to be purchased by 5.00pm on Thursday 4th January. Numbers are limited and there is a cut off time for catering purposes, so don't delay.

The function will commence at 6.00pm for 7pm and will be a sit down dinner with vegetarian options. It is casual attire. Should you or any of your party have any dietary requirements please advise by Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> January.

#### **GPS Trackers**

GPS trackers will be provided daily to each yacht. On the first day, these will be handed out at the briefing. Please put them in the sink onboard. Remember to bring them back to the club at the end of the racing so that the race replays can be created. Information about the trackers will be provided at the briefing.
