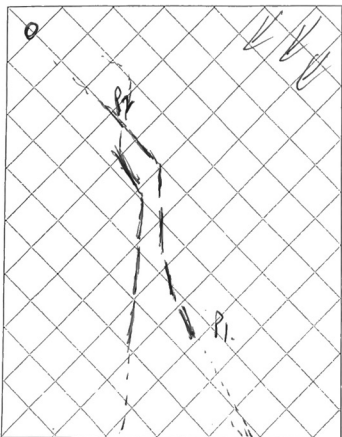

At P1 WARMACHINE ESTABLISHED A WINDOW AND OVERLAP. DURING THE OVERLAP WAR MACHINE WAS HEARD TO YELL "MAYBE AHEAD" AND ALTERED COURSE TO CROSS THE BOW OF BUCK WHILST STILL OVERLAPPED TO WINDOW AND THE KEEP CLEAR BOAT. BUCK WAS MADE TO ALTER COURSE TO AVOID CONTACT. GIVEN THE SEA STATE AND WIND SPEED BUCK TOOK A SAFETY FIRST APPROACH BUT AT THE SAME TIME BUCK WAS INFRINGED UPON. AT POSITION 2 THE OVERLAP WAS BROKEN AND BUCK CAME UP TO PASS AHEAD OF WAR MACHINE.
